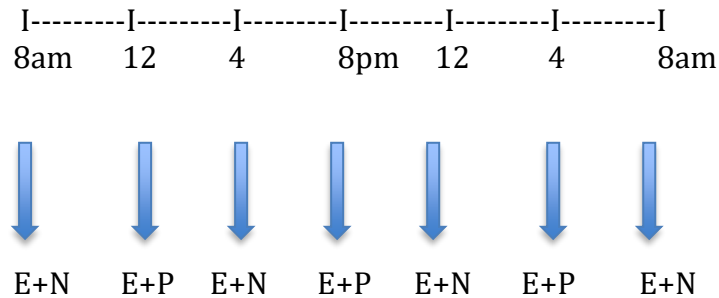


DR KHAN'S

PAIN OR FEVER CONTROL IN SEVERE CASES

This is the highest dose one can do and the most frequent that these meds can be given.



KEY:

E → Empapad or Panado or Calpol (These are all Paracetamol – the dose is 10mg/kg and each 5mls has 125mg of paracetamol in the syrups)

N → Nurofen (this is Ibuprofen – the dose is 10mg/kg and each 5mls of nurofen has 100mg of Ibuprofen so eg. If your child weighs 15kg the dose is – 10 x 15 (kg) which works out to 150mg → So 7.5mls.

P → Ponstan – (This is Mefenamic Acid. The dose is 5-10mg/kg. Each 5mls contains 50mg so for eg. if your child weighs 10kg, you can administer 5 to 10mls of ponstan at one dose)

Ibuprofen(Nurofen) and Paracetamol can be given together.

Mefenamic Acid(Ponstan) and Paracetamol can be given together.
